

Kotryna Jogailaitė - Cultural Transmission Through Royal Alliances

Eva Mattsson's lecture will take place on 23rd of September at 11.00 o'clock at the Faculty of Philology of Vilnius University in aud. 92 (Zinkevičiaus).

Kotryna Jogailaitė - transfer of culture from Lithuania and Poland to Sweden through a royal alliance. An example of how alliance marriages between royal courts spread art and culture across Europe in the 16th century.



Eva Mattsson is an author, art historian and cultural producer with a master's degree in art history and a bachelor's degree in business administration. She is a popular storyteller and in 2018 she made her debut as an author with a biography of Queen Kotryna Jogailaitė. The biography is the first to be written about the Queen and in February 2024 the biography "*Kotryna Jogailaitė - Rožės ir akmens karalienė*" was also published in Lithuanian, by the publishing house **Obuolys** in Lithuania.

In 2021 she published her second book about the House of Vasa.

Her interest in people and learning has inspired new ways of bringing history to life. She has performed four different monologues about Queen Kotryna Jogailaitė at Vasa Castles in Vadstena, Uppsala, Stockholm and Strängnäs.

Since 2006, Mattson runs the company Bring to Life.
