Course annotation: Students get to know the Hungarian alphabet and pronunciation rules. Working with texts relating to everyday life (greetings, introducing, family, shopping, home, food, languages, etc.) The aim of the course is to develop basic understanding, speaking and writing skills in Hungarian relating to everyday conversations, learning to express opinions and feelings, albeit simply.

Lesson 1.

Introducion: the Hungarian alphabet. Rules of pronunciation. Practice of reading through texts. The place of the Hungarian language on the Finno-Ugric language tree.

Lesson 2.

Greetings, introducing. Reading dialogues of the first chapter. Adjectives, antonimes of adjectives. Revision of the alphabet.

Lesson 3.

The definite articles. Languages, countries. Personal pronouns. Conjugation of the verb „to be” and explanation to its correct rules. The definite articles in Hungarian.

Lesson 4.

Vowel harmony and conjugation rules I. What language do you speak? Vowel harmony and conjugation rules – how to put suffixes to any kind of Hungarian words. Memoriters for vowel harmony. Revision of the wordlist of the first chapter.

Lesson 5.

Vowel harmony and conjugation rules II. Remaining dialogues of second chapter. Postpositions indicating place (before, behind, under, above, next to, between.) Here-there. Indefinite conjugation of regular verbs.

Lesson 6.

Numbers and postpositions indicating place I. Ordering in a restaurant, hotel. Numbers from 0–10. Reading dialogues of third chapter. Revision of the vocabulary and grammar of the second and first chapter.

Lesson 7.

Numbers and postpositions indicating place II. Revision of numbers, postpositions indicating place. Where? – usage of suffixes in the context of places. Numbers 11–100.

Lesson 8.

Numbers and postpositions indicating place III. Numbers 100–1000. How many? How much? Which? Which number? Remaining dialogues of the third chapter. Answering to the question verb „Where?“

Lesson 9.

Revision I. Revision of definite articles, personal pronouns, indefinite conjugation of regular words, numbers, suffixes indicating place, vocabulary of I-III chapters.

Lesson 10.

The direct object. How much does it cost? In the shop, buying products. Colors. The direct object. Dialogues of the fourth chapter.

Lesson 11.

Conjugation of irregular verbs. Where? Summarizing question words learnt before. Conjugation of two irregular verbs: to come, to go. Remaining dialogues of the fourth chapter.

Lesson 12.

Indefinite conjugation of several verbs I. Greetings. Dialogues using the verbs „to come“ and „to go.“ Where? –Where to? – Where from? Indefinite conjugation of the verbs ending with -s, -sz, -z and -ik.

Lesson 13.

Indefinite conjugation of several verbs II. Vocabulary of house, flat. Where do you live? Practice indefinite conjugation of the verbs ending with -s, -sz, -z and -ik. The remaining part of the dialogues of fifth chapter.

Lesson 14.

Negation. House, flat, furnitures, rooms. The rules of negation. Revision of where, where to, where from, conjugations. Dialogues of sixth lesson.

Lesson 15.

Plural of nouns and adjectives. Learning to use the plural of nouns and adjectives. The verbs to work, to come. Remaining part of the dialogues of sixth chapter.

Lesson 16.

Revision II. Revision of the 3–6th lessons. Vocabulary, conjugations of irregular and irregular words, negation, plural form of nouns and adjectives.

Lesson 17.

Prefixes indicating directions I. Where? Where to? Where from? Prefixes indicating directions (in, out, up, down, through.) Reading dialogues of the seventh chapter.

Lesson 18.

Prefixes indicating directions II. Revision of prefixes indicating directions. Remaining dialogues of the seventh chapter.

Lesson 19.

Revision III. Revision of 1–7 chapters, grammar and vocabulary.
